WINE LAW: COMPARATIVE ASPECTS AND GLOBAL TRENDS



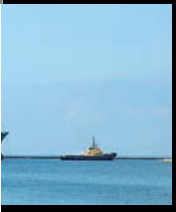
The 9th edition of the EU Wine Law School is hosted by the University of Reims School of Law as part of the Wine & Law Program.
